Projects proposals must meet the following minimum requirements to be considered by the MAAE Grants Committee.

- The applicant must be a current member of the MAAE. (Membership can be [purchased HERE.](#))
- The project must be a new, innovative initiative at the school, which involves meaningful learning objectives. ([See details HERE.](#))
- The project must follow [Manitoba's Visual Art Curriculum](#) guidelines (must involve all four learning areas).
- The project must be able to be completed within 12 months of receiving the grant money.
- The project supervisor (educator/applicant) must submit an article, with photos, at project termination. ([Examples are here.](#))

Please note:

- Upon being awarded grant funding, applicants will receive 75% of the entire awarded amount. Only once original receipts have been submitted, and the 1-2 page article* has been submitted to the MAAE for publication on our website, will the other 25% of the funding be awarded to the recipient.
- Recipients must collect and submit all original receipts (including artists' fees, etc.) for submission to the MAAE.
